












70 YEARS OF GRACE







GN Ramachandran Memorial Lecture



Workshop on "Computer-aided **Drug Designing**





This review analyses the design strategies of nanosystems for effective spatiotemporal signaling to improve immune response to Pancreatic cancer.







Propranolol HCL-containing liposomes were designed to be inhaled via the nose, where the medicine is released slowly for the treatment of migraine.







This article is focused on the recent advancements in gut microbiome research and the potential role of the gutbrain axis (GBA) in developing resilience or susceptibility to stress.



CONVOCATION 2023



• The two-day conference included scientific sessions, panel discussions, eposter presentations, cartoon drawing competitions, and ID quiz.
















EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES
