My project, was a success and after implementation by the company, it proved to be a helipful input to the organisation. I was assigned to New Product Introduction (NPI) Department which primarily dealt with procurement of all required items needed for proper functioning of the hospital I finished my project titled 'Analysis of SCM Process of Capital Bio-Medical Equipment in a Tertiary Hospital and Optimising the same through Implementation of Lean Six Sigma Principles'

The project was primarily aimed at reducing the lead time of their systematic procurement process by improving their existing workflow using various tools relevant to Operations domain. Apart from the project, my day-to-day work included: Evaluating the requests raised by end user departments within the hospital and creating an evaluation report, Data entry into MIS iManagement Information Systems), IOM (Inter Office Memorandum) creation, contacting vendor and requesting for Price Quotation, Maintaining Asset history.

My project was well received by the organisation as well as my cologe. It was a good experience which gave me practical insights into what we learn through tooks and I thank everyone who supported me throughout my two-month journey.






CORPORATE THEATRE WORKSHOP








MSME WORKSHOP


