IgA nephropathy with moderate mesangial hypercellularity, strips of atrophy and hypertensive vascular changes. 2.Suggestive of chronic active TCMR grade IA with segmental sclerosis, negative immunofluorescence, C4d negative, SV40 negative 3.Focal segmental glomerulo sclerosis NOS with mild global glomerulo sclerosis,mild chronic tubule interstitial nephritis	All Nephrologists + Pathologists +PG Doctors

Moderate global glomerulosclerosis in a background of ischemic glomeruli with negative immunofluorescence, interstitial fibrosis/tubular atrophy grade III and hypertensive vascular changes, C4d negative. 2. Mild tubulitis with grade II IF/TA and hypertensive vascular changes with thrombotic microangiopathy, c4d negative. 3. Thrombotic microangiopathy with crescent, mild chronic tubule interstitial nephritis. 4.Suggestive of thrombotic microangiopathy, C4d negative, acute tubular injury and myocyte vacuolation	All Nephrologists + Pathologists +PG Doctors


