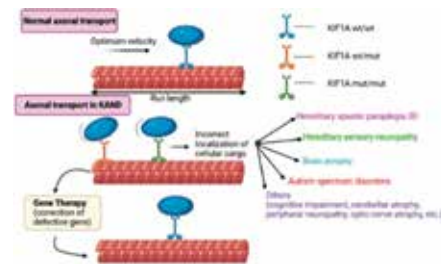

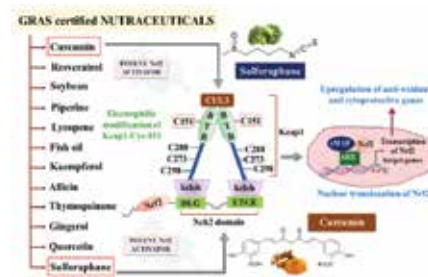

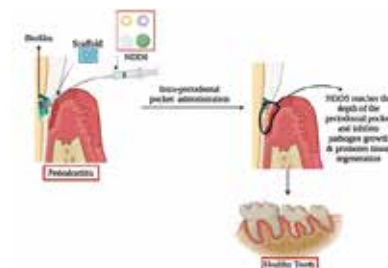


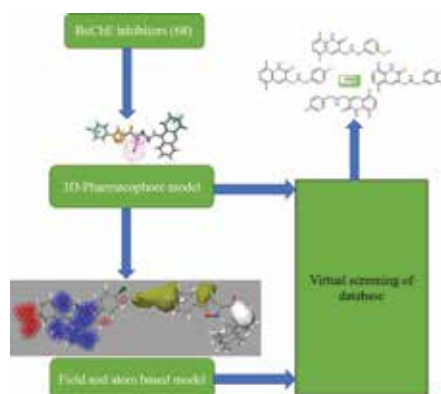

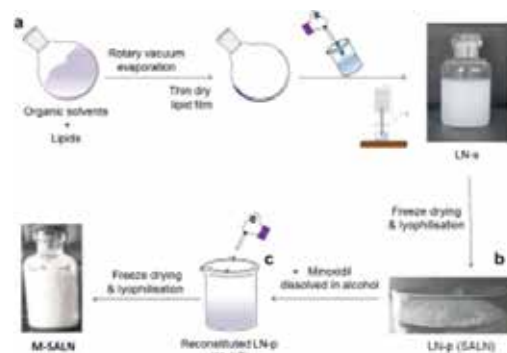

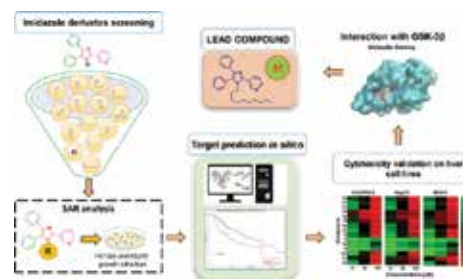

The theme is very relevant in recent times gaining momentum due to microbial resistance. The objectives of the conference were a multipronged approach to anti-microbial drug development, the Impact of diagnostic tools in the early identification of infection,

Factors contributing to antimicrobial resistance, and nanotechnology-mediated approaches to overcome anti-microbial resistance.

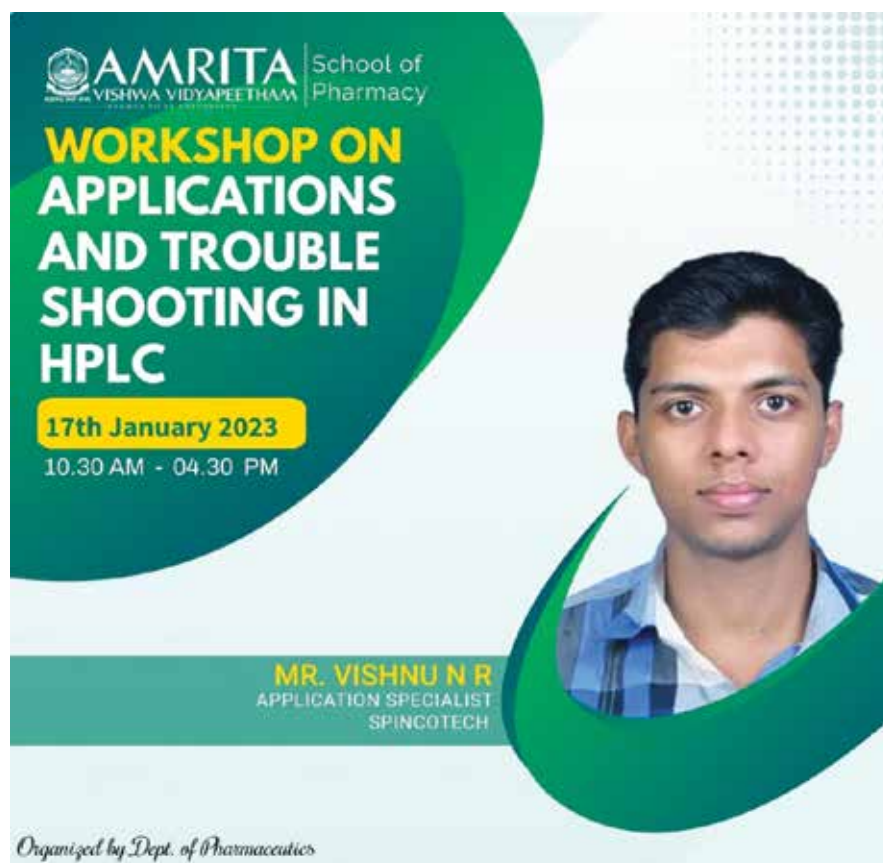
PROGRAMS BY DEPARTMENTS

Department of Pharmaceutics

He highlighted the role of technology in promoting sustainability in the pharmaceutical industry, highlighting advancements in digitalization, automation, and artificial intelligence and machine learning in drug development. The webinar was well-received, and many attendees gained a better understanding of the role that innovation can play in promoting sustainability.



A workshop on troubleshooting in HPLC was held on 17-01-2023 for PG and Ph.D scholars. Mr. Vishnu NR, Application Specialist at Spincotech, covered common issues and applications of HPLC analysis, including baseline drift, peak broadening, and retention time shifts. He demonstrated methods to diagnose and fix these issues, such as adjusting phase composition, column temperature, injection volume, and column cleaning. The workshop also introduced best practices for maintaining HPLC equipment, including calibrating instruments, storing and handling reagents and samples, and following proper cleaning procedures.
