### INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

(Candidates are required to carefully read / understand and must strictly follow the instructions).

- Ensure that all the details printed above are correct and true as per your knowledge. Note: Write to btech@amrita.edu if there is any discrepancy, with proof for necessary rectification.
- You are required to appear for the examination at own expense at the time and centre as printed on the Admit Card, not in any other centre. You are also advised to acquaint yourselves with the location of the exam centre one day prior to the examination.
- You must be present at the Examination Centre allotted to you, 45 Minutes before the commencement of the examination. Candidates will be allowed to enter the Examination Centre after the starting of the Examination.
- You must report to the examination centre with a print copy of this Admit Card along with a valid photo identity card proof issued by the Government without which the candidate will not be allowed to appear for the examination. The candidate must produce, on demand, the Admit Card at the entrance & to the Invigilator.
- Paste a recent Passport size colour photograph/signature on the downloaded Admit Card if your photo/Signature is not printed in the Admit Card.
- Your Admit Card shall be preserved till the end of the Seat Allotment Process & shall produce in original, duly signed by you & invigilator at the time of admission, without which the admission will stand cancelled.
- Check your name in the Roster/Room list and proceed to the designated area. A seat with AEEE 2024 Registration number will be allotted to you. You must occupy the allotted seat ONLY. If you are found appearing in the examination from a seat or room other than the one allotted to you, your candidature shall be cancelled, and no plea would be accepted for it.
- You must strictly follow the instructions of the invigilator at the examination hall.
- The invigilator cannot and will not answer questions related to the questions in the examination.
- No material is not allowed in the Examination Hall. Examination will stand cancelled if you are found possessing any material other than Admit Card.
