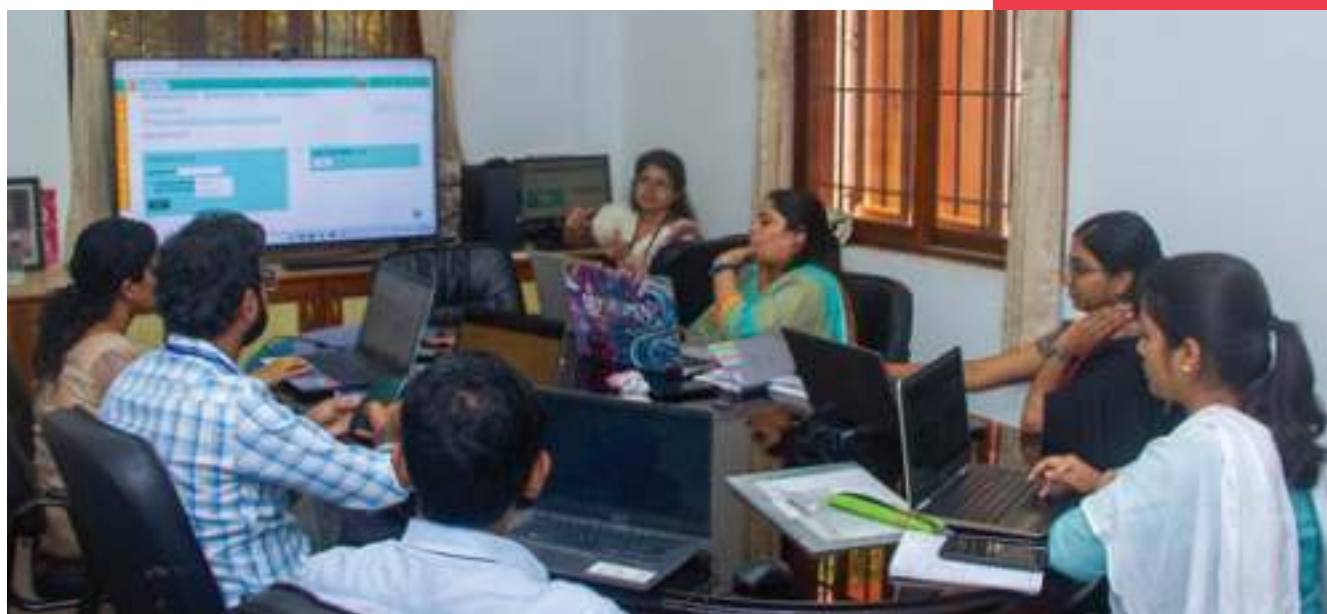
Induction programme for new L&D faculty members
